





Policies to implement and regulate the tempo and direction of the dance.



DEVELOPMENT

Advocacy



Board's method of relating the organization's beliefs, values, and philosophy to the community. Purpose is to create community support for the mission.

Policy Development

- Is it CLEAR?
- Is it CONSISTENT?
- Is it DEFENSIBLE?



Procedures

- Align with policies to designate <u>how</u> the work will be done
- Often specific to one area or aspect of the organization
- Developed and implemented by administration
